
It is important that we plan properly for the future, which is why Haringey Council is creating a comprehensive vision and long term plan for the area.

This forms an important part of an overall Wood Green Regeneration Programme, that sets out how to bring:



- promote the Control Quarter support our existing traders and bring new life to the high street create new employment opportunities for residents and provide a better range of places to shop, eat and have fun























Wood Green is the heart of Haringey, drawing in people from across the borough and beyond to shop, work and have fun. Everyone with a connection to Wood Green is rightly proud of its history as a thriving town centre, and excited about its future as one of the capital's best places to live, work and visit.

We're already spending £4.2million to improve Wood Green's public spaces. We now need to secure the future of the town centre, while unlocking Wood Green's potential for major new housing growth – including on land owned by the council itself.


It is important that we plan properly for the future, which is why Haringey Council is creating a comprehensive plan for the area. This will form an important part of an overall Wood Green Regeneration Programme, that sets out how we'll bring a better town centre, modern housing, and improved connections between the town centre and the cultural quarter as well as between Alexandra Palace & Park and neighbouring areas. Haringey Council has appointed a team of experts to develop a vision plan for the area. The team consists of Fluid experts in urban planning and Soundings leaders in community engagement and consultation to deliver an independent, robust and creative process.

We want to ensure that local people's aspirations for the area feed into the plans and that their opinions are reflected in the final submission. To date we have held a number of Pop Up public events in areas of large footfall in Wood Green, we have also held a number of one to one meetings with community groups and a walk around the area led by residents and community groups.

We would like to invite you to join the Community Liaison Group. This group will act as a sounding board for the team throughout the process and give them the opportunity to gain a better understanding of the area from your local perspective and insights. The next meeting of key resident stakeholder and community groups will take place in the **Green Rooms building (the former Utility Building), 13-27 Station Road, N22 6UX from 6.30-8.00pm on Thursday 29th October 2015.**

COMMUNITY LIAISON GROUP

The Community Liaison Group for Wood Green's Future draws together local representatives to meet regularly with the Council, Councillors, Soundings and Fluid as required to discuss and inform the regeneration project as it evolves.

Role of the Group

- To be representative of the views of the wider community.
 To act as a sounding board for the regeneration project and evolution of the proposals.
- 3. To provide a forum to discuss and exchange a range of thematic issues, to resolve conflicts where possible and to flag up issues of interest.
- **4.** To communicate and distribute information to the wider community* and to collate feedback.
- 5. To review, discuss and inform the public consultation process.

- **Group Meetings' Frame**1. Fluid representatives and Haringey officers will attend all Community Liaison Group meetings.
- 2. Soundings will facilitate and chair Community Liaison Group meetings,
- and will be responsible for meeting reports and administration of meetings.

 3. Membership of the Community Liaison Group is open to representatives of local community groups and tenants or residents associations.

 4. In the case of estates / developments that have no tenants and residents
- associations in place, Soundings will facilitate a process of identifying a representative from those residents.
- 5. It is also open to some interested and committed individuals linked to the local area.
- 6. All Community Liaison Group representatives are requested to nominate a deputy to attend meetings they are unable to attend to ensure continuity of the conversation.
- 7. To ensure a balanced range of views, we generally ask that each organisation has a maximum of 2 representatives at each meeting.
- * We respectfully request that detailed information and/or drawings presented to the Community Liaison Group be handled sensitively and not be widely released by members. The design team will release relevant information as part of the series of public exhibitions and workshops.


