The Haringey (Tottenham Hotspur Stadium Traffic Management Zone) (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No.73) Order 2023

Made: 10th January 2023

Coming into force: 12th January 2023

The Council of the London Borough of Haringey, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6, 45 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^a, and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Haringey (Tottenham Hotspur Stadium Traffic Management Zone) (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No.73) Order 2023 and shall come into force on 12th January 2023.

Interpretation

2. (1) In this Order:-
 - “authorised agent” means the parking services contractor appointed by and acting on behalf of the Council for the purposes of the supervision and enforcement of the provisions of this Order;
 - “bus” and “buses” have the same meaning as in Schedule 1 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016^b;
 - “civil enforcement officer” means a person in uniform authorised by or on behalf of the Council in accordance with section 76 of the Traffic Management Act 2004^c to enforce and supervise the provisions of this Order;
 - “Council” means the Council of the London Borough of Haringey;
 - “enactment” means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment; and
 - “Event Day Commander” means the Senior Officer of the Metropolitan Police Service appointed as the principal co-ordinator of policing and traffic management activities within the Tottenham Hotspur Stadium Traffic Management Zone on a Major Event Day;
 - “goods” means goods of any kind whether animate or inanimate and includes postal packets of any description and “delivering” and “collecting” in relation to any goods includes checking the goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection;
 - “kerb-line” means the imaginary line which is the projection of the line formed by the edge of the carriageway of a street;
 - “maximum parking period” means the maximum period of time during which a vehicle may be left in a parking place referred to in the Schedule to this Order;
 - “minimum return interval” means the minimum period of time, following a vehicle having been taken away from a parking place during the permitted hours, before that vehicle may again be left in that parking place during the permitted hours;
 - “motor cycle” and “invalid carriage” have the same meanings as in section 136 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;
 - “owner”, in relation to a vehicle, means the person in whose name the vehicle is registered under the provisions of the Vehicle Excise and Registration Act 1994^d;
 - “Major Event Day restriction hours” in relation to bus parking places imposed by this order means the period of time commencing 3 hours in advance of the published start time of a Major Event and ending 1 hour after the conclusion of said event;
 - “Major Event Day” means a day on which a Major Event is taking place at Tottenham Hotspur Stadium;

“Major Event” means an event which is planned to take place or which is taking place at Tottenham Hotspur Stadium, with an expected attendance of 10,000 persons or more, not including any staff or contractors engaged in either the operation or management of the aforementioned Stadium or event”

“parking period” means a period of time during which a vehicle may be left in a parking place referred to Schedule 2 to this Order;

“parking place” means an area on a street designated as a parking place by this Order;

“passenger vehicle” means a motor vehicle (other than a motor cycle or invalid carriage) constructed or adapted solely for the carriage of not more than eight passengers (exclusive of the driver) and their effects and not drawing a trailer;

“permitted hours”, in relation to a parking place designated by this Order, means the (inclusive) period specified in column 3 of the item relating to that parking place in Schedule 2 to this Order;

“prescribed hours” in relation to a waiting restriction or loading restriction imposed by this order means the hours specified in the heading of the Schedules to this order;

“street” includes any part of a street;

“the Order of 2021” means The Haringey (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) Order 2021^e - as amended;

“Tottenham Hotspur Stadium Traffic Management Zone” means an area of streets or roads in the vicinity of Tottenham Hotspur Stadium, comprising the streets, roads and lengths thereof referred to in this Order, each of which is subject to certain restrictions during the prescribed hours on Major Event Days, as provided by this Order.

“traffic sign” means a sign of any size, type and colour prescribed and authorised under, or as having effect as though prescribed or authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

“universal service provider”, “provision of a universal postal service” and “postal packet” have the same meanings as in the Postal Services Act 2011^f.

- (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
- (3) Unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2021 shall have the same meaning as in that Order.

Waiting and loading restrictions applicable to restricted streets

3. (a) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait during the prescribed hours in any restricted street specified in Schedule 1A to 1F to this order except, subject to the provisions of the next paragraph, for so long as may be necessary for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading the vehicle at premises adjacent to the street.
- (b) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading the vehicle:
 - (i) in any restricted street or part of street during the restricted hours; or
 - (ii) without prejudice to the provisions of the last foregoing sub-paragraph for a period of more than forty minutes in the same place during the prescribed hours in so far as the same fall between the hours of 11 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. in any restricted street.

The exemptions and provisions regarding waiting and loading restrictions specified in Part V and VI of the Order of 2021 will apply to any applicable restrictions introduced by this order.

Designation of parking places and loading places

4. (1) Each area on a highway comprising the length of carriageway of a street specified in schedule 2, as an area marked out and signed for the use therein of specified classes of vehicles following the conditions specified in this Order in relation to that parking place, is a designated parking place.

Vehicles for which parking places are designated

5. Each parking place referred to in Schedule 2 may be used, subject to the provisions of this Order for the leaving during the permitted hours of such vehicles as are buses.

Alteration of position of a vehicle in a parking place

6. Where any vehicle is standing in a parking place in contravention of the provisions of Article 8, a civil enforcement officer may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle in order that its position shall comply with those provisions.

Movement of a vehicle in a parking place in an emergency

7. A police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer may move or cause to be moved, in case of emergency, to any place they think fit, any vehicle left in a parking place.

Manner of standing in a parking place

8. (1) The driver of a vehicle waiting in a parking place specified in the Schedule during the permitted hours shall cause it so to stand:-
- (a) in the case of a parking place in relation to which special provisions as to the manner of standing of a vehicle in that parking place are specified in column 2 of the Schedule, so as to be in accordance with those provisions;
 - (b) in the case of any other parking place so that the longitudinal axis of the vehicle is at an angle of 90° to the edge of the carriageway nearest to the vehicle and the front or rear wheel of the vehicle is not more than 300 millimetres away from the edge of the carriageway nearest the vehicle;
 - (c) so that every part of the vehicle is within the limits of a parking place, as the case may be;
 - (d) so that no part of the vehicle obstructs any vehicular means of ingress to or egress from any premises adjacent to the side of the road on which the vehicle is waiting.
- (2) For the purposes of sub-paragraph 1(d) of this Article, the expression “premises” shall not include any premises to or from which any furniture is being removed by virtue of the provisions of Article 13(2)(a) or to or from which goods are being delivered or collected by virtue of the provisions of Article 13(2)(b).

Maximum parking period

9. Where a vehicle left in a parking place, the parking period (where specified) shall not exceed the period specified in column 4 of the item in the Schedule relating to that parking place.

Interval before a vehicle may again be left in a parking place

10. No vehicle which having been taken away from a parking place during the permitted hours shall, until the expiration of the period specified in column 5 of the item in the Schedule relating to that parking place (where specified) from the time it was taken away, again be left in that parking place during the permitted hours.

Power to suspend the use of a parking place

11. (1) The Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis or any police officer above the rank of Chief Inspector may suspend the use of a parking place or any part thereof for a period not exceeding twenty-eight days whenever he considers such suspension necessary for maintaining the security of premises in the vicinity of that parking place.
- (2) At the expiration of the period of twenty-eight days mentioned in paragraph 1 of this Article, the suspension of the parking place or any part thereof shall be reviewed by the person who suspended its use and any continuation of the suspension that they consider necessary shall be notified to the council and shall not exceed a further period of twenty-eight days without similar review.
- (3) Any person duly authorised by the council or authorised agent may suspend the use of a parking place or any part thereof whenever they consider such suspension reasonably necessary:-
- (a) for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety;
 - (b) on any occasion on which it is likely, by reason of some special attraction or occurrence, that any street will be thronged or obstructed;
 - (c) for the purpose of any building operation, demolition or excavation adjacent to the parking place or the loading area, as the case may be, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the highway or the cleansing of gullies in or adjacent to the parking place, the laying, erection alteration or repair in or adjacent to the parking place of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any electronic communications network (within the meaning of the Communications Act 2003⁹); or the placing, maintenance or removal of any traffic sign;

- (d) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place on any occasion of the removal of furniture to or from one office or dwelling-house adjacent to that parking place or that loading area, as the case may be, from or to a depository, or another office or dwelling-house;
 - (e) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place at times of weddings or funerals, or on other special occasions.
- (4) A police constable in uniform may suspend for not longer than seven days the use of a parking place or any part thereof whenever he considers such suspension reasonably necessary:-
- (a) for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety;
 - (b) on any occasion on which it is likely, by reason of some special attraction or occurrence, that any street will be thronged or obstructed.
- (5) On the suspension of the use of a parking place or any part thereof in accordance with the provisions of this Article, the person authorising or causing such suspension shall place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to that parking place, or that part thereof, as the case may be, either:-
- (a) a traffic sign indicating that waiting, or, as the case may be, waiting, loading and unloading by vehicles is prohibited; or
 - (b) some other sign as may from time to time be authorised by the council or its authorised agent for the purpose of indicating that a suspension is in force and that waiting, or waiting, loading and unloading by vehicles is prohibited.
- (6) No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to wait in a parking place or any part thereof at any time during which there is displayed in or adjacent to that parking place or that part thereof, as the case may be, a traffic sign or sign authorised by the council or its authorised agent placed in pursuance of paragraph 5 of this Article:
Provided that nothing in this paragraph shall apply:-
- (a) in respect of any vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes or any vehicle which is waiting for any reason specified in Article 13(1)(b), (d) or (e);
 - (b) to anything done with the permission of the person suspending the use of the parking place or the part thereof, as the case may be, in pursuance of paragraph 1, 3 or 4 of this Article, a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer.

Restriction on the use of a parking place

12. During the permitted hours, no person shall use any parking place or any vehicle while it is in a parking place in connection with the sale or offering or exposing for sale of any goods to any person in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for sale of their skill in handicraft or their services in any other capacity.

Restriction on waiting by a vehicle in a parking place

13. (1) Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, any vehicle may wait during the permitted hours in any part of a parking place if the use of that part has not been suspended and if:-
- (a) the vehicle is waiting for a period not exceeding two minutes or such longer period as a enforcement officer may approve to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle or load onto or unload from their personal luggage:
Provided that if the said person is a person suffering from any disability or injury which seriously impairs their ability to walk, or who is blind, the vehicle may wait for so long as may be necessary to enable that person to board or alight from the vehicle or load thereon or unload therefrom their personal luggage;
 - (b) the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond their control or to such waiting being necessary in order to avoid an accident;
 - (c) the vehicle is being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes or, not being a passenger vehicle, is being used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties provided that in all the circumstances it is reasonably necessary in the exercise of such powers or the performance of such duties for the vehicle to wait in the place in which it is waiting;
 - (d) the vehicle is waiting only for so long as may be necessary to enable it to be used in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (e) the vehicle is being used by a universal service provider in the course of the provision of a universal postal service and the vehicle is waiting only for so long as may be reasonably necessary for postal packets to be collected or delivered at premises or posting boxes adjacent to the place in which the vehicle is waiting;

- (f) the vehicle, not being a passenger vehicle, is waiting only for so long as may be necessary to enable it to be used for any purpose specified in Article 11(3)(c);
 - (g) the vehicle is waiting with the written consent of the council or authorised agent and such conditions and requirements as they may impose are being complied with.
- (2) Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, any vehicle may wait during the permitted hours in any part of a parking place if the use of that part has not been suspended and if:-
- (a) the vehicle is in actual use in connection with the removal of furniture to or from one office or dwelling-house adjacent to the parking place from or to a depository or another office or dwelling-house;
 - (b) in any other case the vehicle is waiting for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading the vehicle at premises adjacent to the parking place in which the vehicle is waiting and the vehicle does not wait for such purpose for more than twenty minutes or for such longer period as a civil enforcement officer may approve.
- (3) Except as provided by this Order, the driver or person in charge of a vehicle shall not cause or permit that vehicle to wait in a parking place during the permitted hours.
- (4) The driver of a vehicle waiting in a parking place by virtue of the provisions of paragraph 1 or 2 of this Article shall cause it so to stand in accordance with the provisions of Article 8.
- (5) Nothing in the foregoing provisions of this Order shall be taken as authorising anything which would be a contravention of any Regulations made or having effect as if made under section 25 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Placing of traffic signs, etc.

14. The council shall:-

- (a) place and maintain in or in the vicinity of each parking place referred to in the Schedule, traffic signs indicating that such parking place may be used during the permitted hours for the leaving only of the vehicles specified in Article 4 respectively;
- (b) carry out such other work as is reasonably required for the purposes of the satisfactory operation of a parking place.


Suspension of existing provisions

15. Whilst this Order continues in force and without prejudice to anything done or any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this Order, during the prescribed hours on any day that is a major event day, the provisions of The Haringey (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) Order 2021 and The Haringey (Charged-For Parking Places) Order 2021 will be suspended only insofar as they apply to any length of street specified in the Schedules to this Order.

Revocation

16. Without prejudice to anything done or any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this Order, The Haringey (Tottenham Hotspur Stadium Event Days) (Waiting Restrictions) (No.1) Experimental Traffic Order 2020 and The Haringey (Tottenham Hotspur Stadium Event Days) (Bus Parking Places) (No.1) Experimental Traffic Order 2020 are hereby revoked.

The Council of the London Borough of Haringey, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^a, as amended, and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby makes the following Order:-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Haringey (Tottenham Hotspur Stadium Traffic Management Zone) (Event Day) (Moving Traffic Restrictions) (No. 20) Order 2023 and it shall come into force on 12th January 2023.

Interpretation

2. (1) In this Order:-
 - “bus”, “local bus”, “pedal cycle” and “police vehicle” have the same meaning as in Schedule 1 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016^b;
 - “causing” includes permitting;
 - “Council” means the Council of the London Borough of Haringey;
 - “enactment” means any enactment, whether public general or local and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment;
 - “Event Day” means a day on which a Major Event is taking place at Tottenham Hotspur Stadium;
 - “Major Event” means an event which is planned to take place or which is taking place at Tottenham Hotspur Stadium, with an expected attendance of 10,000 persons or more, not including any staff or contractors engaged in either the operation or management of the aforementioned Stadium or event;
 - “Event Day Commander” means the Senior Officer of the Metropolitan Police Service appointed as the principal co-ordinator of policing and traffic management activities within the Tottenham Hotspur Stadium Traffic Management Zone on an Event Day;
 - “motor vehicle” has the same meaning as in section 136 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;
 - “map based schedule” means the map attached to and to be read in conjunction with the Order of 2021, which depicts the restrictions, prohibitions, cycle lanes, routes for pedal cycles only, , bus lanes, bus-only routes and speed limits imposed by this Order, and, in conjunction with the map schedule legend, identifies the type of each particular restriction, prohibition, provision, or speed limit and, if appropriate, certain of its governing provisions
 - “Order of 2021” means The Haringey (Moving Traffic Restrictions) Order 2021^c
 - “permit holders’ vehicle” means either:-
 - (a) a vehicle displaying either:
 - (i) a valid Tottenham Controlled Parking Zone ‘TN’ residents’ permit or business permit, or a valid Tottenham Event Day Controlled Parking Zone ‘TED’ residents’ permit or business permit, or a valid Essential Service User’s permit, or a valid Special Parking Permit, or a valid Car Club Permit, issued in respect of that vehicle under the provisions of The Haringey (Charged-For Parking Places) Order 2021, or

- (ii) a valid Homes for Haringey parking permit, issued in respect of that vehicle in respect of a housing estate car park located in or only accessible from a prescribed street; or
 - (iii) a valid Tottenham Hotspur Football Club car park permit; or
 - (iv) such other permit issued in respect of that vehicle as may be authorised from time to time for use within the Tottenham Hotspur Stadium Traffic Management Zone by either the Event Day Commander, or the Council, as the case may be; or
- (b) a vehicle, the driver or passenger of which presents upon demand a valid proof of address, indicating that said driver or passenger is a resident of a prescribed street;
- “prescribed hours” means either:-
- (a) in respect of Worcester Avenue N17, a period of time commencing at 8 a.m. on an Event Day and ending 1 hour after the conclusion of the Major Event, or as specified by the Event Day Commander; or
 - (b) in respect of Love Lane N17 and the length of Whitehall Street N17 which lies between its junctions with Love Lane and High Road, Tottenham and referred to in items 2 and 5 respectively in Schedule 1, a period of time on an Event Day commencing 3 hours in advance of the published start time of a Major Event and ending 1 hour and 30 minutes after the conclusion of said event, or as specified by the Event Day Commander; or
 - (c) in respect of Park Lane N17 and White Hart Lane N17 and referred to in items 4 and 6 respectively in Schedule 1, a period of time on an Event Day commencing 45 minutes in advance of the published start time of a Major Event and ending 1 hour and 30 minutes after the conclusion of said event, or as specified by the Event Day Commander; or
 - (d) in respect of any other street or length of street referred to in Article 3 or 5(2) or Schedule 1, 2, 3 or 4, a period of time on an Event Day commencing 3 hours in advance of the published start time of a Major Event and ending 1 hour after the conclusion of said event, or as specified by the Event Day Commander;

“prescribed street” means a street, road or length thereof referred to in Article 3 or 5(2) or in Schedule 1, 2, 3 or 4;

“proof of address” means either a valid driver’s licence, or a utility bill or a Council Tax bill dated within 3 months of an Event Day, or a bank statement dated within 3 months of an Event Day, issued in respect of a person residing at an address within a prescribed street;

“Tottenham Hotspur Stadium Traffic Management Zone” means an area of streets or roads in the vicinity of Tottenham Hotspur Stadium, comprising the streets, roads and lengths thereof referred to in this Order, each of which is subject to certain restrictions during the prescribed hours on Event Days, as provided by this Order; and

“traffic sign” means a sign of any size, type and colour prescribed and authorised under, or having effect as though prescribed or authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

- (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
- (3) Any reference in this Order to a named street, road or part thereof shall be construed as a reference to a street, road or part thereof having that name which lies within the London Borough of Haringey.
- (4) Any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule shall, unless the context otherwise requires, be construed as a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

Prescribed routes

3. Subject to the provisions of Article 4:-

- (1) No person shall cause any vehicle to enter into or proceed in that length of High Road, Tottenham N17 which lies between the southern kerb-line of White Hart Lane N17 and the northern kerb-line of Lansdowne Road N17 during the prescribed hours;
- (2) No person shall cause any vehicle to enter into or proceed in a street, road or part thereof specified in Schedule 1 during the prescribed hours.

For the avoidance of doubt, the aforementioned prohibition shall be deemed to apply to all vehicles, including pedal cycles.

- (3) Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (6) following, no person shall cause any motor vehicle to enter into or proceed in a street, road or part thereof specified in Schedule 2 during the prescribed hours.
- (4) No person causing any vehicle to proceed in a street or road specified in column (2) of Schedule 3 shall, upon reaching its junction with the street or road specified in column (3) of Schedule 3, thereupon cause that vehicle to turn right into that street or road specified in column (3) of Schedule 3 during the prescribed hours; and
- (5) No person causing any vehicle to proceed in a street or road specified in column (2) of Schedule 4 shall, upon reaching its junction with the street or road specified in column (3) of Schedule 4, thereupon cause that vehicle to turn left into that street or road specified in column (3) of Schedule 4 during the prescribed hours.
- (6) No person causing any vehicle to proceed in a street or road specified in column (2) of Schedule 5 shall, upon reaching its junction with the street or road specified in column (3) of Schedule 5, thereupon cause that vehicle to enter into that street or road specified in column (3) of Schedule 5 during the prescribed hours.

Exemptions and exceptions

4. (1) Nothing in paragraphs (1), (2), (3), (4), (5) and (6) of Article 3 shall apply in relation to:-
 - (a) a police vehicle; or
 - (b) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
 - (c) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; or
 - (d) a vehicle proceeding in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by a traffic sign placed on the highway pursuant to section 66 or section 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
- (2) The Event Day Commander may direct that, from time to time within the prescribed hours, nothing in paragraph (1) of Article 3 shall apply in relation to:-
 - (a) a local bus; or
 - (b) a pedal cycle; or
 - (c) a permit holder's vehicle; or
 - (d) a vehicle requiring access to premises, located within either: that part of High Road, Tottenham that is a prescribed street, or within a prescribed street only accessible therefrom; or
 - (e) any other vehicle proceeding with the authorisation of the Event Day Commander.
 Provided that nothing in the preceding paragraph shall permit a vehicle to enter into or proceed in a prescribed street during the prescribed hours where the Event Day Commander has directed that no vehicle may do so.
- (3) Nothing in paragraph (2) of Article 3 shall apply in relation to a vehicle proceeding with the authorisation of the Event Day Commander.
- (4) The Event Day Commander may direct that, from time to time within the prescribed hours, nothing in paragraph (3) of Article 3 shall apply in relation to:-
 - (a) a permit holder's vehicle; or
 - (b) a vehicle requiring access to premises located within a prescribed street, or only accessible therefrom; or
 - (c) any other vehicle proceeding with the authorisation of the Event Day Commander.
 Provided that nothing in the preceding paragraph shall permit a motor vehicle to enter into or proceed in a prescribed street during the prescribed hours where the Event Day Commander has directed that no motor vehicle may do so.

Suspensions

5. (1) During the prescribed hours and without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this Order, whilst this Order continues in force:-
 - (b) The Haringey (Tottenham Event Days) (Prescribed Route) Traffic Order 1997^d; and
 - (c) Articles 3(a), 3(b), 3(c), 3(d), 3(e), 3(f) and 3(k) of The Haringey (Prescribed Routes) (Spurs Match Day) (No. 1) Traffic Order 2010^e,

are hereby suspended.

- (2) Notwithstanding anything done at the direction of the Event Day Commander and without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this Order, whilst this Order continues in force, the Order of 2021 inclusive of any associated map based schedule or any other such order which contain the following restrictions are hereby suspended during the prescribed hours:-
- (a) any such Order or provision thereof as provides a point 'no entry' restriction with exemption for 'emergency access only' in Church Road, N17, located at a point 17 metres east of the eastern kerb-line of King Street N17;
 - (b) any such Order or provision thereof as provides a point 'no entry' restriction with exemption for 'emergency access only' in Park Lane, N17, located at the common boundary of Nos. 86 and 88 Park Lane;
 - (c) any such Order or provision thereof as provides a 'fire gate' closure in James Place N17, located at a point 12 metres north of the northern kerb-line of Kings Road N17;
 - (d) any such Order or provision thereof as provides a 'fire gate' closure in Love Lane N17, located at a point 4 metres north-west of the north-western kerb-line of Whitehall Street N17; and
 - (e) any such Order or provision thereof as provides a 'fire gate' closure in Tenterden Road N17, located at a point 1.5 metres west of the western kerb-line of Whitehall Street N17.


Revocation

The Traffic Management Company working on behalf of Tottenham Hotspur Football Club and on direction of the Event Day Commander shall place and maintain traffic signs indicating the limits of each restriction detailed in Article 3 of this order restrictions as identified in the Schedule to this order.

1. **Notice is hereby given** that the Council of the London Borough of Haringey ('the Council') on 10th January 2023 made the above-mentioned Order under sections 6, 45 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. **The general effect of the Orders will be**, to make permanent the restrictions for Event Day (being a day on which a 'Major Event', that is, an Event with an expected attendance of 10,000 persons or more, is to take place at Tottenham Hotspur Stadium, other than an Event constituting a National Football League 'NFL' game being played at that stadium), as detailed below:-
 - (a) from 8 a.m. on the day of an Event until 1 hour after the conclusion of that Event (or as directed by the Event Day Commander - being the Senior Police Officer co-ordinating Police and Traffic Management activities in respect of that Event), to prohibit all vehicles (including pedal cycles) from entering WORCESTER AVENUE N17;
 - (b) from up to 3 hours before the advertised start time of an Event until 1 hour and 30 minutes after the conclusion of that Event (or as directed by the Event Day Commander), to prohibit all vehicles (including pedal cycles) from entering LOVE LANE N17 and WHITEHALL STREET N17 between its junctions with Love Lane and High Road, Tottenham;
 - (c) from up to 3 hours before the advertised start time of an Event until 1 hour after the conclusion of that Event (or as directed by the Event Day Commander), to:-
 - (i) prohibit all vehicles, other than (when directed as safe to do so by the Event Day Commander) buses, pedal cycles, permit holders' vehicles and vehicles requiring access to premises from entering HIGH ROAD, TOTTENHAM N17 between its junctions with Lansdowne Road and White Hart Lane;
 - (ii) prohibit all vehicles (including pedal cycles) from entering CHURCH ROAD N17 between its junctions with Brereton Road and High Road, Tottenham; and PARK LANE N17 between its junctions with High Road, Tottenham and Sutherland Road;

Or any valid Controlled Parking Zone parking permit issued by the council that may be introduced in the future that is respective to the Tottenham Hotspur Stadium Traffic Management Zone.

When the Haringey (Tottenham Hotspur Stadium Traffic Management Zone) (Event Day) (Moving Traffic Restrictions) (No. 20) Order 2023 is in force, the provisions of the Haringey (Tottenham Event Days) (Prescribed Route) Traffic Order 1997, the Haringey (Prescribed Routes) (Spurs Match Day) (No. 1) Traffic Order 2010 as they apply in relation to roads covered by the aforementioned Traffic Order, will be suspended.

The Haringey (Moving Traffic Restrictions) Order 2021 or any other such order which contains the restrictions specified in point 2(c) (vii) are hereby suspended during the prescribed hours

- (h) to suspend the loading bays, disabled bays and taxis ranks and provide waiting restrictions which will operate between the hours of 8 a.m. and 8.30 p.m. at the following locations:-
LOVE LANE N17 – (i) loading bay: the west side, outside White Hart Lane Station; (ii) taxi ranks: the north-east side, outside Moselle House; (iii) disabled bays: the north-east side, outside Moselle House;
PARK LANE N17 – disabled bay: south side, outside No. 214 Park Lane;
WHITE HART LANE N17 – (i) loading bay: the north side, outside Nos. 24 to 30 White Hart Lane; (ii) loading bay: the north side, opposite its junction with Peshurst Road;

- (i) to suspend the 'TED' (Event Day) permit holder's parking places and provide waiting restrictions which will operate during the Event Day restriction hours (that is, between the hours of 5 p.m. and 8.30 p.m. when an Event Day occurs on Monday to Friday inclusive, or between the hours of 12 noon and 8 p.m. when an Event Day occurs on a Saturday, Sunday or a Public Holiday), at the following locations:-
SHELBOURNE ROAD N17 - (i) the north-west side, outside Nos. 14-32 Shelbourne Road; (ii) the north-west side, outside Nos. 34-44 Shelbourne Road; and (iii) the north-west side, outside Nos. 48-52 Shelbourne Road.
- (j) to suspend the 'WG' 'shared-use' parking place and provide waiting restrictions which will operate during the Event Day restriction hours, at the following locations:-
BEDFORD ROAD N22 - the arm fronting Nos. 1-2 Station Cottages, the south-east side outside Nos. 1-2 Station Cottages;
- (k) to suspend the Event Day 'pay by phone' parking place and provide waiting restrictions which will operate during the Event Day restriction hours, at the following location:-
PRETORIA ROAD N17 - (i) the east side, opposite its junction with Durban Road (20 metres in length); and (ii) the east side, opposite its junction with College Road (15 metres in length);
- (l) to suspend the disabled persons parking places and provide waiting restrictions which will operate during the Event Day restriction hours, at the following location:-
SHELBOURNE ROAD N17 - the north-west side, outside No. 46 Shelbourne Road;
- (m) to suspend the 'TED' permit holder's parking places and provide bus parking places (for the use of 'coaches') which will operate during the Event Day restriction hours, at the following locations:-
TARIFF ROAD N17 - (i) the east side, at the side of No. 100 Brantwood Road; (ii) the east side, outside No. 6 Tariff Road; (iii) the east side, outside Triumph Trading Estate, Tariff Road; and (iv) the north-west side, at the side of No. 105 Northumberland Park (Note: the existing parking place markings at this last location will be extended by 2.3 metres to accommodate the bus parking place);
- (o) to suspend an existing 'WG' 'shared-use' parking place and provide a bus parking place which will operate from up to 3 hours before the advertised start time of the Event until 1 hours and 30 minutes after the conclusion of that Event, at the following location:-
WHITE HART LANE N22 - the south-east side, opposite Nos. 1-13 White Hart Lane;

TARIFF ROAD N17 - (i) the west side, outside Jeco Works, Tariff Road; and (ii) the west side, outside United House, No. 11 Tariff Road; and
WHITE HART LANE - the north side, outside Haringey Sixth Form College;
- (q) to suspend the existing 'pay by phone' parking place and provide a bus parking place which will operate from up to 3 hours before the advertised start time of the Event until 1 hours and 30 minutes after the conclusion of that Event, at the following location:-
STATION ROAD N22 - the north-east side, opposite Nos. 143-145 and Alexandra Palace Station, Station Road;
- (r) to suspend the existing 'AP' 'shared-use' parking place and provide a bus parking place which will operate during the Event Day restriction hours, at the following location:-
BEDFORD ROAD N22, the north-east side opposite Alexandra Motors and its junction with Alexandra Park Road;
- (s) to provide bus parking places which will operate from up to 3 hours before the advertised start time of the Event until 1 hours and 30 minutes after the conclusion of that Event on existing lengths of non-Event Day advisory footway parking and Event Day 'single yellow line' waiting restrictions at the following locations:-

- (u) to provide bus parking places which will operate from up to 3 hours before the advertised start time of the Event until 1 hours and 30 minutes after the conclusion of that Event on existing 'single yellow line' waiting restrictions, at the following locations:- PRETORIA ROAD N17 - (i) the east side, opposite Nos. 12-17 Pretoria Road (38 metres in length); and (ii) the east side, opposite Nos. 1-8 Pretoria Road (38 metres in length);
- (v) to amend the hours of operation of existing event day waiting restrictions in High Road, Tottenham N17, between the northern kerb-line of Bruce Grove and the boundary with the London Borough of Enfield, from operating between 11 a.m. and 11 p.m. on event days to operating between 3 p.m. and 11 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive and between 10 a.m. and 11 p.m. on Saturdays, Sundays and bank holidays;
- (w) to prohibit parking in certain sections of Brereton Road N17, Bromley Road N17 Church Road N17, Moselle Place N17, Vicarage Road N17 and Whitehall Street N17 from up to 3 hours before the advertised start time of an Event until 1 hour after the conclusion of that Event (or as directed by the Event Day Commander).

When The Haringey (Tottenham Hotspur Stadium Traffic Management Zone) (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No.73) Order 2023 is in force, the provisions The Haringey (Charged-For Parking Places) Order 2021 and The Haringey (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) Order 2021 as they apply in relation to roads covered by the aforementioned Traffic Order specifically points (e) to (w), will be suspended.

3. **Further notice is hereby given** that the Council have approved the suspension of an existing cycle track during the Event Day restriction hours, in CHESTNUT ROAD Whilst this suspension remains in effect (as will be indicated by traffic signs), this length of footway will be a route for the use of pedestrians only.
4. *NOTES: These Orders supersede similar provisions at the above locations implemented by way of experimental Orders made under section 9 of the 1984 Act (which are revoked).*
5. **Date of operation:** The Order will come into operation on 12th January 2023.
6. **Further details:** Copies of the Orders referred to above and other relevant documents may be inspected at the reception desk, Alexandra House, 10 Station Road, Wood Green, N22 7TR within six weeks of the date on which the Orders were made. Email TMO@haringey.gov.uk for booking details.
7. **Application to the high court:** Any person desiring to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it does not comply with the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made there under have not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within six weeks of the date on which the Orders were made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
