The Haringey (Charged-For Parking Places) (Amendment No. 24) Order 2022

Made: 6th May 2022

Coming into force: 12th May 2022

The Council of the London Borough of Haringey, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order shall come into force on 12th May 2022 and may be cited as The Haringey (Charged-For Parking Places) (Amendment No. 24) Order 2022.


Interpretation

2. (1) In this Order “the Order of 2021” means The Haringey (Charged-For Parking Places) Order 2021 (b).
 - (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
 - (3) Unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2021 shall have the same meaning as in that Order.

Amendment to the Order of 2021

3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this Order, the Order of 2021 shall have effect as though for the item numbered 10 to part 31 of Schedule 2 of that Order there were substituted the item similarly numbered and set out in the Schedule to this Order.

EXCLUSION TO PARKING PERMIT ELIGIBILITY – DEVELOPMENT AT 5 & 7 ST MARYS CLOSE N17 – CAR FREE DEVELOPMENT

The Haringey (Charged-For Parking Places) (Amendment No. 24) Order 2022

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Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Haringey on 6th May 2022 has made the above mentioned Orders under sections 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

The general effect of the Order, would be to exclude Development at 5 & 7 St Marys Close N17, from the list of properties within the Tottenham Hale North Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ), that are eligible for the issue of parking permits for use within the CPZ, on the grounds that is a car free development

Date of operation: The Order will come into operation on 12th May 2022.

Application to the high court: Any person desiring to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it does not comply with the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made there under have not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within six weeks of the date on which the Orders were made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
