### THE HARINGEY (NORTHWOOD ROAD N6) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2023



The 'Council' of the London Borough of Haringey being the traffic authority for certain roads in that London borough is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near those roads and in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and of all other enabling powers the Council hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order shall come into force on 24<sup>th</sup> July 2023 and may be cited as the Haringey (Northwood Road N6) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2023.
2. Whilst the Order is in force, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to: -
  - (a) enter or proceed in the lengths of roads specified in column 2 of Schedule 1 to this Order during the dates and times specified in column 1 of that Schedule; and
  - (b) wait, load or unload in the lengths of roads specified in column 2 of Schedule 2 to this Order during the dates and times specified in column 1 of that Schedule other than those vehicles exempted from such restrictions specified in column 2 to that Schedule;
3. Whilst this Order is in force, any parking place, loading bay, bus stop, bus stand, bus lane, cycle lane or pedestrian crossing located in a length of road specified in column 2 of Schedule 2 to this Order shall be suspended during the dates and times specified in column 1 of that Schedule.
4. 'The Haringey (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) Order 2021' and 'The Haringey (Charged-For Parking Places) Order 2021' are hereby temporarily amended as detailed in Article 2(b) and 3 to this Order.
5. The prohibitions and restrictions specified in articles 2 and 3 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs as prescribed by The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
6. Nothing in Article 2 to this Order shall apply to: -
  - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the works;
  - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes;
  - (c) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform, a traffic warden or a civil enforcement officer;
  - (d) any vehicle requiring ingress to, and egress from, a property in a prohibited length of road, if the works allow.
7. The Order may continue in force for up to 18 months unless extended by the Secretary of State.

Closure of Northwood Road carriageway from junction with Orchard Road to 20m north of Parkland Walk bridge structure.

### Schedule 2 – Suspensions & Introduction of No Waiting/No Loading at Any Time

26 <sup>th</sup> July 2023 for 1 day Times: 24hr CONTINGENCY – ADDITIONAL DATES BETWEEN 26 <sup>TH</sup> JULY AND 10 <sup>TH</sup> AUG MAY BE REQUIRED SHOULD DELAYS OR COMPLICATIONS OCCUR WHEN COMPLETING THE SURVEY WORKS.	Suspension of CPZ parking on south east side of Northwood Road from junction with Orchard Road to Parkland Walk bridge, approx. 20m.

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(1)**

The Council of the London Borough of Haringey has made the Temporary Traffic Order described below:-

<b>Reason for 14(1) Order</b> – Bridge Inspection and Bridge repair works	
<b>Operational dates</b>	<b>General Effect of Order</b>
Dates: Wed 26 <sup>th</sup> July 2023 for 1 day Times: 8am-6pm	i) Closure of Northwood Road N6 carriageway from junction with Orchard Road to 20m north of Parkland Walk bridge structure.  Diversion route will be via Stanhope Road, Shepherds Hill, A1 and vice versa.  ii) Suspension of CPZ permit parking and introduction of no waiting/no loading on south east side of Northwood Road N6 from junction with Orchard Road to Parkland Walk bridge, approx. 20m.
Dates: Mon 24 <sup>th</sup> July 2023 – Fri 28 <sup>th</sup> July 2023 inclusive Times: 24hr	Suspension of CPZ permit parking and introduction of no waiting/no loading on north west side of Northwood Road N6 from junction with Orchard Road to Parkland Walk bridge, approx. 25m.

CONTINGENCY – ADDITIONAL DATES BETWEEN 26<sup>TH</sup> JULY AND 10<sup>TH</sup> AUG MAY BE REQUIRED SHOULD DELAYS OR COMPLICATIONS OCCUR WHEN COMPLETING THE SURVEY WORKS.

The provisions of the Orders shall apply only at such times and as directed by traffic signs. For road closures, alternative routes will be directed by traffic signs.
