"The aim of the service is to provide a safe, secure and child friendly environment where children can have face-to-face contact with families, and those close to them"

At the Maya Angelou Centre we provide Parenting Assessments and a Supervised Contact service. Our opening times are:

Mon - Thurs 10am to 6.30pm Friday 10am to 4.45pm Saturday 10am to 5pm Sunday 10am to 4pm

Room only bookings are available Monday to Sunday, subject to availability.

We offer a range of contact services including but not limited to:

Fully supervised contact

(with a dedicated worker and includes a report)

2 Supported contact

where we can observe beginnings and endings, also throughout if required (dedicted worker and short report)

Rehabilitation contact

where there is a schedule of gradually increasing contact which moves to the family home (with a dedicated worker and includes a report), subject to distance

Family Network Meetings

where we bring the family and their wider network together, to create a Safety Plan for keeping children safe, emotionally and physically well and happy.

Our services also conduct Parenting Capacity Assessments and PAMs assessments for people with learning difficulties for a fee.
