# Finsbury Park 2023 — Review





### Overview

- Finsbury Park hosted 15 events held over63 event days in total
- > 57 build, break and rest days were also used
- Estimated that 370,000 people attended and enjoyed events in Finsbury Park
- The largest hirer in 2023 was Festival Republic, who hired 31% of physical space in the south side of the park
- ➤ The longest event duration was 23 days, which was the Easter Funfair operated by Manning's Amusement.

### Major events in Finsbury Park

- > Classified as a 'Major' event if it has more than 10,000 in attendance
- Outdoor Events Policy states:
  - Finsbury Park can host up to 5 x 3-day weekends each year
  - ➤ No major event to take place during the school summer holidays
- ➤ In 2023, Finsbury Park hosted 6 major events days, Jamie T, Pulp and The 1975 as well as the three-day Wireless Festival.
- > Each day had an attendance of up to 45,000
- > Build, break and rest days totalled 19 days
- ➤ Within the rest week, the Haringey Events Team in partnership with Festival Republic, staged two free community events. The long running Haringey Schools concert as well as the new local artist event Finsbury Fest.
- ➤ Both community events will return in 2024.





### Issues highlighted in 2023

#### Vibrations

➤ Vibrations related complaints saw an increase in 2023 and in response to this, Festival Republic has commissioned a further study into vibrations following the one completed in 2022.

#### Side Street Security

Following reports that during Festival Republic's multi-event weekend of there being some key buildings and side-streets having issues with ASB, FR will review security deployment during the multi-event weekend and place security personnel at key 'hotspot' locations.

#### Ecology and Tree Protection

Ecology and tree protection issues were a top complaint received in particular in relation to the Krankbother hire and there are a number of keys actions highlighted in the annual review setting out plans to mitigate these concerns.

#### > Air Quality

The impacts on air quality during events has also been the topic of complaints. To investigate this, the Council has commissioned the instalment of air quality monitors in key locations around the park ahead of the 2024 events in which the Council will analyse figures and develop an action plan if
