THE HARINGEY (FINSBURY PARK FESTIVAL REPUBLIC) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) (ATTRO) ORDER 2024


Made: 3rd July 2024

Coming into force: 5th July 2024

The 'Council' of the London Borough of Haringey being the traffic authority for certain roads in that London borough, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, The London Borough of Islington, The London Borough of Hackney and Transport for London, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited for a purpose relating to danger or damage connected with terrorism on or near those roads and in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1)(b) by virtue of section 22C(4) and (5), 22D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (RTRA), as amended and of all other enabling powers the Council hereby makes the following Order.

1. In this Order;
'authorised agent or designated person' means any event stewards or security guards employed by a company contracted to provide security for the Finsbury Park events.
2. This Order shall come into force on 5th July 2024 and may be cited as the Haringey (Finsbury Park Festival Republic) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (ATTRO) Order 2024.
3. Whilst the Order is in force, no person shall enter or proceed in, or cause any vehicle to enter or proceed in the lengths of roads specified in column 2 of the Schedule to this Order during the dates and times specified in column 1 of that Schedule; and
4. Article 3 of this Order shall be commenced, suspended or revived at the discretion of a police constable to such extent and for such period as they may specify. The police constable may delegate this authority under section 22D(5)(d) RTRA to an authorised agent or designated person for such period as they think necessary for a purpose relating to danger or damage connected with terrorism.
5. Pursuant to section 22D(5)(c), RTRA (which makes provision conferring a power on a police constable in relation to the placing of structures or signs, and the occasional deployment of search and screening capability), measures will be placed in the lengths of roads specified in column 2 of the Schedule to allow for the closure of these roads to vehicular traffic, passengers of such traffic and pedestrians except those vehicles or pedestrians allowed at the discretion of police constable or authorised agent or designated person.
6. Nothing in Article 3 to this Order shall apply to: -
 - (a) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform, an authorised agent or designated person, a traffic warden or a civil enforcement officer;
7. The Order may continue in force for up to 18 months unless extended by the Secretary of State.

THE HARINGEY (FINSBURY PARK FESTIVAL REPUBLIC) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) (ATTRO) ORDER 2024

The Council of the London Borough of Haringey, in consultation with the London Boroughs of Islington, Hackney and Transport for London, under section 14(1) by virtue of sections 22C and 22D Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has made the Temporary Traffic Orders described below for a purpose relating to danger or damage connected with terrorism:-

At events in the UK where large crowds gather it is common practice to implement measures which reduce the risk to the public from any potential terrorist attacks. The implementation of such measures are not an indication that there is any specific intelligence to suggest that there is an increased security risk to the event or the local environs, but are reflective of the current UK national threat level which is at SUBSTANTIAL – an attack is likely.

In consideration of the UK threat level and the fact that Finsbury Park will be hosting concerts, including the Wireless Festival, on 5th, 6th, 7th, 12th, 13th and 14th July, an ATTRO will be implemented on these dates between specific times when there will be large numbers of pedestrians leaving the park. The ATTRO (Anti-Terrorism Traffic Regulation Order) will allow road closures to be implemented to reduce the danger of vehicles to people on foot leaving the venue.

The provisions of the Orders shall apply only at such times and as directed by traffic signs. For road closures, alternative routes will be directed by traffic signs.
