Your instalments are due on or before the first day of the month. If you pay by direct debit, you can choose to pay on the 1st, 15th or 25th of the month.

You must pay your instalments on or before the due date. If you do not, you will be sent a reminder. If you fall behind again you will lose the right to pay by instalments. Failure to pay will result in legal proceedings and additional costs payable by you.
