Outcome of Statutory Consultation and Works Notice - Bikehangar (Cycle Parking Storage) – 2024-25 Batch 1

You may recall that we consulted you in July 2024 regarding the possible introduction of 31 cycle hangars (Cycle Parking Storage) at various locations across the borough. On behalf of the Council, we would like to thank all those who took the time to have their say and make their views known.

How to apply for a space in a cycle hangar

Applications for cycle hangar spaces are managed by Cyclehoop, the company that supplies and manages the arrangement. Cyclehoop will only start taking requests once a cycle hangar has been installed. A maximum of two spaces can be allocated per person, but if a Bikehangar is under-utilised over a period of time, then Cyclehoop will issue additional spaces if required. Priority will be given to the residents who requested for a cycle hangar to be installed and are on our waiting list.

Cycle Storage/Bikehangar

Bike hangars are communal bike lockers offering storage for six bicycles. A single Bikehangar unit occupies less than one car parking space. The units are easy to open as they have self-lifting doors, and the steel design protects cycles from vandalism, theft, and wet weather.
