WHY GET INVOLVED?

Taking part in restorative processes allows you to:

- Tell your side of the story
- Get answers to your questions
- Help the child involved in crime to understand the impact of their actions
- Help the child to put right some of the harm they have caused
- Encourage the child not to cause any more harm in the future.

WHAT ARE THE OPTIONS?

Haringey's Victim Liaison Co-ordinator facilitates communication between you and the child, which can involve:

- Receiving a letter of explanation
- Meeting face-to-face with the child
- Having your impact statement read out to the child
- Getting answers to your questions through indirect mediation.

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

The victim liaison co-ordinator will contact you. They will answer any questions you may have and help you decide if restorative justice is right for you.

Your involvement is totally voluntary and your details will be kept confidential.
