## Statutory Consultation

### Proposed Zebra Crossing on Gladstone Avenue N22

Dear Resident or Business,

As part of this year's Road Danger Reduction Programme, we propose installing a zebra crossing on Gladstone Avenue near the junction with High Road N22. The zebra crossing will help give pedestrians priority over traffic, and help them to cross safely.

Details of the proposal are listed below and set out on the plan overleaf:

- Install a zebra crossing on Gladstone Avenue, with associated lighting and road markings.
- Provide high skid resistant surface treatment on the approach to the zebra crossing.
- Remove obstructive tree (replacement tree to be planted at a suitable location)
- Relocate obstructive advertising sign unit

In order to comply with legal regulations, we are required to carry out a Statutory Consultation. This is the legal part of the consultation process and takes the form of a Public Notice advertised in the local press, London Gazette and in the local area to inform the public.

The statutory consultation process normally runs for three weeks but given the approaching festive period, it will run for five weeks until **14 January 2026**. You can send us your comments and/or objections by scanning the QR code above or using the link to complete our online feedback form. Alternatively, you can use the enclosed Freepost feedback card. If you object to the scheme, please give reasons for your objection.

All objections and comments will be considered before a decision is made. If it is decided to go ahead with the crossing, we will inform you when works are scheduled to start.
